HEERF REPORTING – STUDENT PORTION

In acknowledgement of Arkansas State University Three Rivers (ASUTR) receiving an amendment of an increase of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund on February 19, 2021, ASUTR assures compliance under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act and Section 314(a)1 of CRRSSA to provide emergency financial aid grant to students. This supplemental funding award of \$334,662 was pursuant to the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSSA).

On April 15, 2021 \$334,662 of CRRSSA funds was distributed to 435 students. In order to receive funding, students must have been enrolled in the Spring 2021 semester as the census date. Students whose EFC was within the PELL eligibility range received \$470 if enrolled in 1-5 semester hours; \$658 if enrolled in 6-8 hours; \$800 if enrolled in 9-11 hours; and \$940 if enrolled in 12 or more hours. Students whose EFC was not within the PELL eligibility range received \$350 if enrolled in 1-5 semester hours; \$490 if enrolled in 6-8 hours; \$595 if enrolled in 9-11 hours; and \$700 if enrolled in 12 or more hours.

In acknowledgement of Arkansas State University Three Rivers (ASUTR) receiving an amendment of an increase of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund on May 12, 2021, ASUTR assures compliance under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act, Section 314(a)1 of CRRSSA, and Section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act to provide emergency financial aid grant to students. This supplemental funding award of \$1,245,323 was pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

On August 10, 2021 \$334,215 of ARPA funds were distributed to 435 students based on PELL eligibility and hours enrolled.

On November 22, 2021, \$497,340 of ARPA funds were distributed to 928 students based on their enrollment from March 13, 2020 to the Fall 2021 semester. The amount of aid distributed to each student was based on Pell eligibility and hours enrolled.
