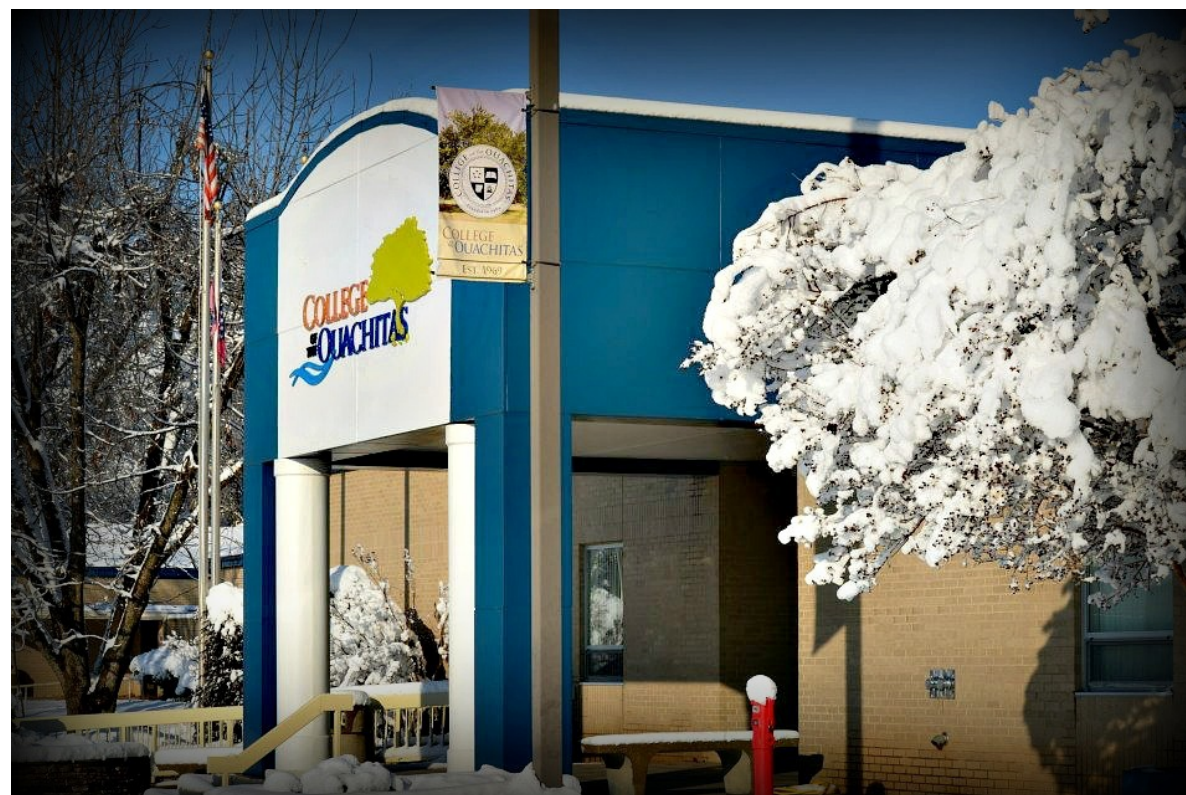

Library Display

Beginning with the defeat of the Army of Northern Virginia in April 1865, a catastrophic Civil War came to an end. To commemorate the sesquicentennial of this significant moment in American history, College of the Ouachitas Library, in association with the Center for Arkansas History and Culture in Education, presents "Fought in earnest: Civil War Arkansas," fifteen free-standing panels featuring materials from the collection of the Arkansas Historical Commission that provide insight into life in Arkansas between 1861 and 1865. The presentation will be on campus from March 15 through April 15. The library will also highlight a number of its holdings concerning the war, along with artifacts from the Jenkin's Ferry battleground. Be sure to make plans to view this display.
