CARES ACT REPORTING

In acknowledgement of Arkansas State University Three Rivers signing and returning its Certification and Agreement on April 16, 2020, Arkansas State University Three Rivers assures compliance under Section 18004(a)(1) to provide emergency financial grants to students.

Arkansas State University Three Rivers has been granted \$334,662 from the Department of Education to provide to its students. On May 26, 2020, \$233,970 was distributed to 422 students. An estimated 460 students were Title IV eligible in May 2020.

In order to receive funding, students must have been enrolled in the Spring 2020 semester as of March 13, 2020, have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or be eligible to file a FAFSA, and be a U.S. citizen. Students enrolled completely in on-line classes were not eligible to receive funding. Qualifying students who were enrolled in 1-5 semester hours received \$300; enrolled in 6-8 hours received \$420; enrolled in 9-11 hours received \$530; and enrolled in 12 or more hours received \$600.

A second and final distribution of \$100,692 was made on October 23, 2020 to 160 students who were enrolled during the spring 2020 semester, reenrolled in the Fall 2020 semester, and meet current Department of Education requirements. Qualifying students who were enrolled in 1-5 semester hours received \$350; enrolled in 6-8 hours received \$485; enrolled in 9-11 hours received \$585; and enrolled in 12 or more hours received \$690.

As of the reporting date December 31, 2020, a total of \$334,662 of CARES Act funds have been distributed to students.
